



## BMW, taxi carjacked

A SPORTS car and a taxi have been carjacked in separate incidents in NSW, police said.

The first theft took place after a small dark-coloured hatchback rammed a BMW M6 as it pulled into a driveway in Rose Bay Avenue in Sydney's Bellevue Hill about 7pm (AEST) yesterday, police said.

When the 26-year-old male driver got out of the car, he was approached by two of three balaclava-wearing men from the hatchback, who threatened him.

The man fled and reported the incident to police. The stolen car had a NSW registration HH8888 and was believed to be worth about \$200,000.

In the second incident, two men stole a taxi at knifepoint near Goulburn, in southern NSW.

Police said the taxi picked up two passengers at a service station on the Hume Highway at 2am this morning.

One of the men allegedly produced a knife and threatened the driver as he drove along nearby Murrays Flat Road.

The 45-year-old driver was forced from his taxi and the men drove off towards the highway.

Police said they were searching for two men in their early 20s, of white/European appearance with slim build.

One of them had a red goatee beard and wore a grey hooded jacket and blue jeans, while the other wore a red hooded jacket.

The stolen taxi is a white Commodore with registration TC226.

Police warned anyone who sees either vehicle or the two taxi-robbers not to approach but call Triple 0.
