Teen charged over spate of robberies

Two teenage boys have been charged, one over a string of robberies, following a failed carjack attempt in Sydney's west.

Police said a 30-year-old man was stopped in his car on George Street at Granville about 11pm (AEST) on Sunday when two 17-year-olds tried to pull him from the car and steal it.

He managed to escape in his vehicle and soon afterwards stopped to report the incident to police officers in a highway patrol car.

While he was telling them what had happened, he saw a car driving past which matched the description of the car his attackers had been driving.

After a short police pursuit, two teenage boys were arrested in the car park of a hotel at Granville.

One 17-year-old boy has been charged with 10 offences, including robbery in company, assault with intent to rob in company, being an unaccompanied learner driver, stating a false name and address and obtaining a benefit by deception.

The charges relate to robberies on June 27, July 2 and July 8.

He was refused bail and is expected to appear before Parramatta Children's Court today.

The other 17-year-old has been charged with assault with intent to rob in company.

He was granted conditional bail and is due to appear in Parramatta Children's Court on August 2.
