Left for dead after accident

A 24-year-old man is in a critical condition after being hit by a stolen motorbike in Sydney's north-west overnight.

The man was crossing Pennant Hills Road at Thornleigh about 1am when he was struck by a southbound motorcycle, police said.

The rider of the motorcycle and a passenger fled, leaving behind a Yamaha motorcycle which was later confirmed as stolen, police said.

Ambulance officers were called to treat the injured pedestrian shortly after 1am.

"He had serious head injuries and was taken to Westmead Hospital," an spokeswoman for the Ambulance Service of NSW said.

The man was still in the operating room and in a critical condition this morning, a spokeswoman for Westmead Hospital said.

The male motorcycle rider was described as having a solid build and wearing a dark jacket and pants, police said.

The other man was of smaller build and wearing dark shorts and a T-shirt.

The motorcycle was a blue and silver Yamaha 750CC.
